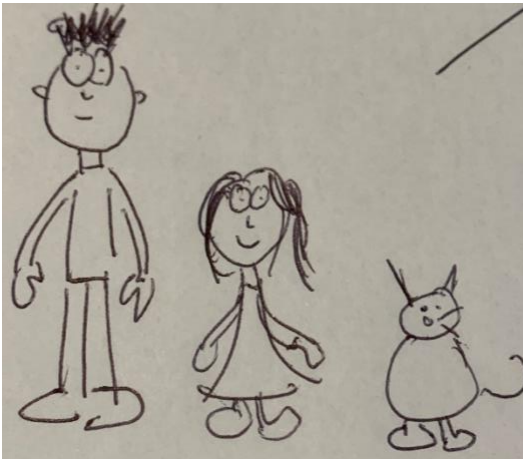
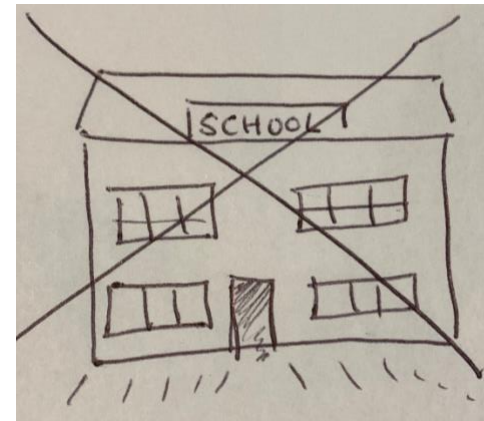


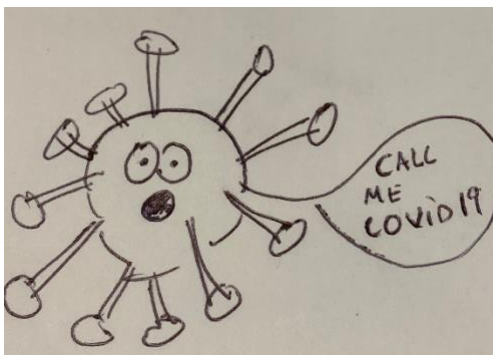
Sally and Billy live with their family. They have a cat called Tabby too.



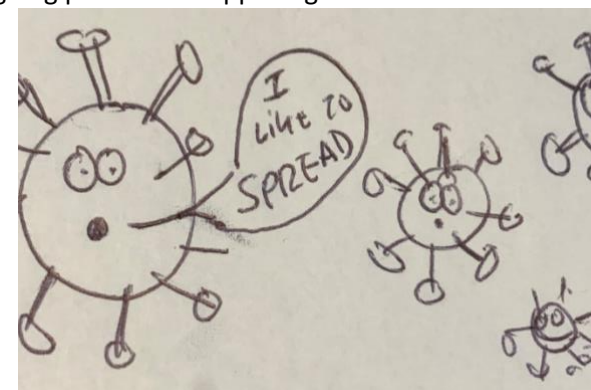

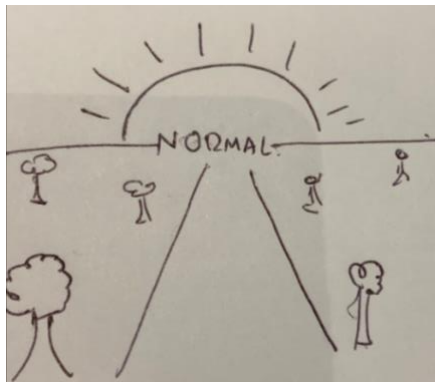
Some boys and girls like Sally and Billy are going to have video calls with people because they can't go to see them. Not everyone is able to do this though.
